THIS WEEK'S FOCUS

Faithful perseverance is not the basis of salvation, but it is the evidence of those who have genuinely repented of sin and trusted in the person and work of Jesus Christ.

QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION *(Use along with **Reading: Ante Faciem Dei**)*

- What is the author's serious warning in verses 4-6 and who is it meant for?
- What illustration does the author use to underscore his warning? How do other passages of Scripture, specifically Genesis 3:17-18 and Jesus' Parable of the Sower in Mark 4:14-19 help clarify his meaning?
- Why is it *impossible* for those who have apostatized ("fallen away") to repent and trust in Jesus Christ?
- Is the gospel the basis of your eternal security ("full assurance of hope")? Does your life demonstrate the reality of a heart transformed by the gospel? What are some evidences of genuine faith recorded in verses 9-12 that help re-affirm our eternal assurance?
