## QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION *(Use along with Reading: Ante Faciem Dei)*

- Who is Luke? What do we know about him? (Colossians 4:10-14; 2 Timothy 4; Acts).
- Why did Luke write his gospel (verses 3-4), and what is it primarily about? Who is his audience(s) (verse 3)? What is the difference between Luke's Gospel and Acts (Acts 1:1-5)?
- What are some unique features of Luke's gospel from the Synoptic Gospels and the Gospel of John?
- How does knowing that Luke is the revealed word of God affect how you read the book?
- Why did Luke take great care to ensure his account was orderly and historically accurate? Why is it essential for our faith?
- What does Luke's prologue reveal about God and ourselves?
