## THIS WEEK'S FOCUS

In this week's passage, God wields his sovereign sword against his enemies, redeems His remnant Israel, and assembles his people for joyful worship in Jerusalem.

## QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION *(Use along with Reading: Ante Faciem Dei)*

- What does the mythical sea creature Leviathan symbolize?
- What does verse one reveal about the nature of God and his providential plans?
- Contrast this vineyard with the vineyard of chapter 5. What do they represent?
- How do these verses testify to God's faithfulness to his people?
- What satisfied God's wrath (verse 4)? How does this amazing truth impact your daily life?
- How did he use the nations for Israel's good (verses 7-11)? Do you consider God's chastisement a privilege of being a child of God?
- By His sovereign purposes, what harvest is God gleaning from around the world (Verse 12)? Is worship (personal and corporate) a priority in your life?
- What does Isaiah mean by the repeated phrase "in that day"?
