Scripture: Isaiah 31-32

THIS WEEK'S FOCUS

In this week's passage, Isaiah prophesies about a coming righteous reigning King who will defeat Judah's enemies and provide deliverance, protection, and refuge for God's people.

QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION *(Use along with Reading: Ante Faciem Dei)*

- How would you summarize God's message to Judah up to this point? What are the repeated themes, and why do they bear repeating?
- Explain the two analogies Isaiah uses about God in verses 4-5.
- Are you clinging to idols that need to be cast away? What is the only antidote to faithlessness?
- What king perfectly embodies righteousness and justice (32:1; Isaiah 9:6-7; Isaiah 11; Isaiah 16)? Does the reality of the reigning king bring you hope?
- What warning does God pronounce on the complacent women of verses 9-13 and why? Why do we sometimes fail to heed God's warnings?
- Contrast the false security described in 9-14 with reliable protection in verses 15-18. When will this blessing come to fruition?
