Scripture: Isaiah 44:1-23

THIS WEEK'S FOCUS

God is our Rock and Redeemer who has saved us by the power of his Holy Spirit, releasing us from the delusion of idolatry to God-delighting worship.

QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION *(Use along with Reading: Ante Faciem Dei)*

- What incredible promise does God make in verses 1-5? When was this promise fulfilled (Acts 2)? Where do you turn for contentment and satisfaction when you are spiritually dehydrated (verse 3)?
- Why does God call himself a Rock (verse 8)?
- What is an idol? How do we identify idols in our lives (verse 9)? Despite the absurdity of idols, why do we return to them?
- Why does God blind the eyes and hearts of these idolators (verse 18)?
- According to verse 21, what does God want Israel (and us) to remember? How has God redeemed us?
- What is the appropriate response for God's gracious redeeming work (verse 23)? Why is creation itself shouting in worship (Romans 8:19-23)?
