Scripture: Isaiah 48

THIS WEEK'S FOCUS

God's glory is purposed in all He does, is revealed in His work of salvation, and is declared with joy to all the nations.

QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION *(Use along with Reading: Ante Faciem Dei)*

- What does it mean that God is sovereign? How does this truth impact your daily life (cares, decisions, behavior, etc.)?
- How had Judah forgotten/forsaken their identity? Are there commands of God that you have ignored?
- Explain how God's revelation is an act of divine grace.
- How had God revealed himself to his people in the past (verses 1-5)? What are the new things that God plans to reveal to his people (verses 6-8)?
- Discuss how God is jealous for his glory and worship (verse 9-11; Ephesians 1:5-6). How is the manifestation of God's glory our benefit? Do you trust God's promises and rest in His perfect work?
- What is God revealing about Himself in verses 12-16?
- Who is the Spirit-empowered servant of the Lord of verse 16 (42:1; Hebrews 1:1-3)?
- How does God remain the Holy One by redeeming rebel sinners (2 Corinthians 5:21)?
- What is God's command in verse 20? Does the thought of sharing the gospel bring you joy? Why or why not?
- How does this text anticipate Jesus Christ and his gospel?
