Scripture: Isaiah 6

## THIS WEEK'S FOCUS

Isaiah 6 reveals our need for cleansing and spiritual renewal through the vision of God, the commission of Isaiah, and the eviction of the people of God.

## QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION *(Use along with Reading: Ante Faciem Dei)*

- How was Isaiah able to see the unseeable God? How did he respond to this incredible sight, and how did this experience impact him?
- What activity is going on in God's throne-room? Why did the seraphim cover their faces and feet (Revelation 5:11-12)?
- Why the word holy repeated three times? What does it mean that God is holy?
- Why doesn't Isaiah join in the heavenly chorus (verse 5)?
- What did Isaiah do to receive atonement for his sin? Explain how Isaiah's atonement was accomplished purely by God's grace. What ultimate atoning work does this point to?
- Like God did with Abraham and Moses before him, what immediately follows Isaiah's atonement? What is the mission of God? Has God called you to serve on gospel mission abroad or locally?
- What command does God give in verses 9-10? Why would the people be unwilling to repent (2 Corinthians 4:4; Mark 4:11; Jeremiah 17:9; Ephesians 2:1-3)?
- When it comes to the mission of God, what does it mean that we are responsible for *faithfulness*, not *fruitfulness*? Who is responsible for producing the fruit of repentance?
- Why does God use the plural "us" with his commission (verse 8; John 12:37-41)?
- Explain how the cross displayed the greatest display manifestation of God's majesty, holiness, and glory.
