Scripture: Luke 20:41-21:4



THIS WEEK'S FOCUS

Jesus demonstrates He is the true and greater King from the line of David. He warns the people of the self-righteous behavior of the scribes which will lead to condemnation. In contrast he praises a lowly widow for giving sacrificially in worship of her God.

QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION (Use along with Reading: Ante Faciem Dei)

- 1. What kind of King were the people anticipating?
- 2. Read Psalm 110. How would this Psalm have informed the Jewish people's views on what the Messiah would look like?
- 3. How is Jesus a greater King/Messiah then they were thinking?
- 4. Why does Jesus warn the people to beware of the scribes?
- 5. How have we behaved similarly to the scribes?
- 6. If we are rooted in the gospel, how should that prevent us from emulating the behavior of the scribes?
- 7. What does Jesus praise of the widow's offering reveal to us about worship?
- 8. What is the difference between her offering and the scribes?
- 9. What areas of your own life did you find convicting when comparing the scribes offering and the widow's?
- 10. How does this passage give you deeper appreciation for God's redeeming grace?
