THIS WEEK'S FOCUS

The spiritual life must take the spiritual posture of prayer.

QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION (Use along with Reading: Ante Faciem Dei)

- 1. Why was it Jesus' custom to visit the Mount of Olives?
- 2. What command does Jesus give his disciples twice in this passage (verses 40, 46)? Why do we often treat prayer as optional rather than as essential to our lives?
- 3. Discuss how prayer is an act of spiritual battle. What temptations do you regularly battle that demand the spiritual weaponry of prayer?
- 4. What can we learn from the way Jesus prayed in this text and other passages of Scripture? What was his posture that should also characterize our prayer?
- 5. What are some practical ways you can cultivate a greater discipline of prayer? What distracts you from praying the way that you would like to?
- 6. Do we pray as Jesus to remove hardship yet surrender to his ultimate will?
- 7. What was Jesus praying to be released from (verse 42)? What does this teach us about the dual nature of Christ (God and man)?
- 8. How does our understanding of the gospel influence the way we pray?
- 9. What happened as the disciples attempted to engage in spiritual battle through prayer? What can we learn from this?
