Scripture: Psalm 23

## THIS WEEK'S FOCUS

Jesus is the all-satisfying Shepherd who lovingly cares for his people by providing rest, leading them through adversity, protecting them from the Enemy, and serving them an everlasting banquet of blessings.

## QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION (Use along with Reading: Ante Faciem Dei)

- 1. Why are the letters in LORD capitalized in this psalm (verse 1)?
- 2. What are the two metaphors that David uses to describe our all-satisfying God?
- 3. Explain why Jesus is uniquely qualified to provide lasting rest. What are some places we foolishly seek rest? Discuss ways to incorporate spiritual rest in your life this new year.
- 4. How does our Shepherd guide us into the paths of righteousness (verse 3)? How do we know we are drifting from him?
- 5. What does it mean that he provides us rest and spiritual life "for his name's sake" (verse 3)?
- 6. Share when you've experienced time in the "valley of the shadow of death" (verse 4) and how God navigated you through. What do the Shepherd's rod and staff symbolize?
- 7. How can we live without fear while living in a sinful world amidst the lies of the Enemy (verses 4-5)?
- 8. Discuss how the gospel comforts us with the truth that God will never abandon us.
- 9. How does the reality of God's never-exhaustive goodness and mercy toward you change how you think and behave?
- 10. What is the glorious hope of all who have trusted Christ, as revealed in this passage (verses 5-6)?
