THIS WEEK'S FOCUS

Even where disbelief is prominent, the empty tomb displays the reality of Jesus' resurrection.

QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION (Use along with Reading: Ante Faciem Dei)

- 1. After the Sabbath, why did the women come to the tomb on Sunday (verse 1)? What were they expecting and hoping to accomplish?
- 2. Who do the women encounter at the empty tomb? What has been the work of angels throughout Luke's gospel (Luke 1:11, 26; 2:9; 22:43)?
- 3. What is the angels' message to the women at the tomb?
- 4. Along with regularly reading God's Word, how can we remind ourselves of Jesus' atoning death and glorious resurrection (verses 6-8)? Why do we need frequent reminders?
- 5. Why is the gospel central to the Christian faith?
- 6. Does the good news of the resurrection move you to tell others who need to hear? How can we grow in our boldness in sharing the gospel with others?
- 7. With whom have you shared the gospel that responded in disbelief? What are some ways you can continue to minister to him/her?
