THIS WEEK'S FOCUS

When the resurrection of Jesus Christ is seen and believed it transforms all of life.

QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION (Use along with Reading: Ante Faciem Dei)

- 1. As illustrated in this text, why was hospitality a characteristic of Jewish (verses 28-30)? Why is hospitality a gospel issue, and is it normative in your life?
- 2. Although he was an invited guest, what role did Jesus play at the house? Discuss what it means that Jesus is the consummate host.
- 3. Why were the disciples' eyes divinely prevented from recognizing Jesus (verse 16)? What opened their eyes to risen Christ's presence (verses 31-32)? Discuss how this illustrates salvation (Psalm 3:8).
- 4. What does this passage reveal about Jesus? What is different about his resurrection compared to other resurrections in the Gospel accounts?
- 5. How did these disciples describe their experience (verse 32)? What prompted their excitement? Do you approach the Scriptures as God's Word that points to life-changing truth? Why must correct theological knowledge always be wedded to genuine faith?
- 6. How did the disciples change after they recognized the risen Jesus (verses 16-17, 33-35)? How does the reality of the resurrection *the gospel* practically influence how you behave, perceive the world, and make decisions? Share some ways the gospel has and is changing you.
