THIS WEEK'S FOCUS

The hope in this dark world is the light of the world: Jesus Christ.

QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION (Use along with Reading: Ante Faciem Dei)

- 1. What type of darkness does Isaiah refer to, and what is its scope (Isaiah 9:2; Romans 2)? Why does humanity love darkness (John 3:19)?
- 2. What is the struggle between darkness and light conveyed throughout Scripture? What hope do we have of overcoming spiritual darkness around and in us (John 1:1-5)?
- 3. Share examples of self-righteous, respectable sins that we practice today. Why are they tolerated? What areas of your life still need the healing power of Christ?
- 4. What solution do we have when we face the darkness of sin around and in us? Discuss what Jesus means by claiming he is the light of the world (John 8:12).
- 5. How do we keep from losing hope when we experience distress or feel overwhelmed by sin and suffering?
- 6. Who do you know that needs to hear the hope of the gospel of Jesus Christ?
