1. Read carefully each statement.
2. Do not respond on the basis of what you think is a desired response, but on the basis of what you have experienced or believe.
3. Often the statement will have more than one part to it and all may not apply to you. If that is the case the “very much applies” response should not be used, even though one part of the statement does very much apply. Use #4 only when the entire statement “very much applies.
4. The same is true with the zero response of “does not apply at all”. This should only be used if the entire statement does not apply at all, not if only one part of the statement does.
5. Use the following scale:
 - 0 - If the entire statement does not apply to you.
 - 1 - If the statement or part of it vaguely applies to you.
 - 2 - If some of the statement applies to you.
 - 3 - If most of the statement applies to you.
 - 4 - If the entire statement very much applies to you.
6. Once you have complete part one of the Spiritual Gift Survey you can fill in the subtotal line by adding the 5 responses across. Of instance the top line would be numbers: 1, 26, 51, 76, and 101. Add these together to get your subtotal in that category.

1. Any line which totals **15** or more is definitely a gift area for you. The closer to **20** (which is the highest score possible) the more this gift is manifested in you.
2. If you scored **6-14** in any category, this indicates that this gift may be developing in you or that you are naturally talented in that area. Of course, there is a greater chance of gifting the closer you score to **20**.
3. And finally, any category that you score **5** or below, you can be reasonable sure this is **not** a gift you presently have.

Once you have identified your gifts, take the time to review their definition. It will also be important for you to know what areas of church ministries these gifts can be used to benefit the body of Christ (1 Corinthians 12:7). We would be happy to help you with that as well!
