Scripture: Luke 24:13-27



THIS WEEK'S FOCUS

God's Word centers on the person and work of Jesus Christ and the good news that all who believe on him are saved from sin and granted eternal life.

QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION *(Use along with Reading: Ante Faciem Dei)*

1. Summarize the events that led up to this passage.
2. Why didn't the two disciples recognize the risen Jesus (verse 16; Luke 9:45, 18:34)?
3. What is necessary to see Jesus for who he truly is – to rightly conclude that he is the risen Son of God (Matthew 16:17)? Discuss how this emboldens us to share the gospel while also encouraging us to pray that God opens the eyes of unbelievers we know and love.
4. Why does the omniscient Jesus ask what they are discussing (verses 17-19a)?
5. What did they believe about Jesus, and why did this make them sad and confuse them about the empty tomb?
6. Are the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus simply facts, or have they transformed your life?
7. Why did Jesus rebuke them, and how did he correct their perspective about Jesus (verses 25-27)?
8. Where do we see the sovereignty of God revealed in this text?
9. What is the focal point of the Scriptures (verse 27)? How does this change the way you approach your Bible reading and study? Share some ways we can miss the main point of God's Word even though our intentions are sincere.
