## QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION (Use along with Reading: Ante Faciem Dei)

- 1. What is the history between the Jewish people and Haman's ancestry, the Agagites (Exodus 17; 1 Samuel 15?
- 2. Who would we have expected to receive a promotion at the beginning of this chapter (2:19-23)? Have you been overlooked or slighted?
- 3. What hope do we have in these circumstances (Psalm 73)? Why did Jesus intentionally endure betrayal and rejection (1 Peter 2:23; Hebrews 12:2)?
- 4. Why do you think Mordecai refused to bow to Haman?
- 5. How did word get to Haman about Mordecai's behavior? How can we combat the pride of trying to gain favor, power, or position (John 3:30)?
- 6. What similarities do you see between King Ahasuerus and Haman? Why?
- 7. Discuss how sinful anger makes us irrational.
- 8. How is anger linked to murder (Matthew 5:21-22; James 1:19-20)? How does the gospel free us from murderous anger and promote humility, peace, and love for others?
