## THIS WEEK'S FOCUS

The relationship that Christians have with God in Christ Jesus is essential to forming a firm identity and the foundation for living wisely.

## QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION (Use along with Reading: Ante Faciem Dei)

- 1. Who is James, who wrote this letter (verse 1a; Acts 1:13)? How does he identify himself?
- 2. What happened in James's life to change his view of his half-brother Jesus (1 Corinthians 15:7)? Has this identity change occurred in your life?
- 3. What does it mean to be a servant or slave of Jesus Christ? Why does he and other biblical writers find it praiseworthy to be a slave?
- 4. Is there an earthly relationship vying for the supreme relationship spot in your life? How can we battle the temptations to replace our relationship with Christ with an earthly one?
- 5. This letter is addressed to the "twelve tribes in the dispersion." Is it also for us today? Why did James use the Old Testament language to describe them (Acts 11)?
- 6. What does it mean for us to live as exiles? Do you treat this world as home?
- 7. Why is wisdom necessary for living on this side of eternity? Discuss how wisdom begins with a clear understanding of our identity.

## **GOSPEL OBSERVATIONS**

- The supremacy of the risen Jesus Christ is the relationship we need for transforming our identity.
- Serving Jesus in all our lives is the greatest, most joyful, and fundamental truth in a Christian's life.
- To be part of God's people is to be part of the greatest story: Redemptive History.
- To be part of God's people today is to learn how to live as exiles.
